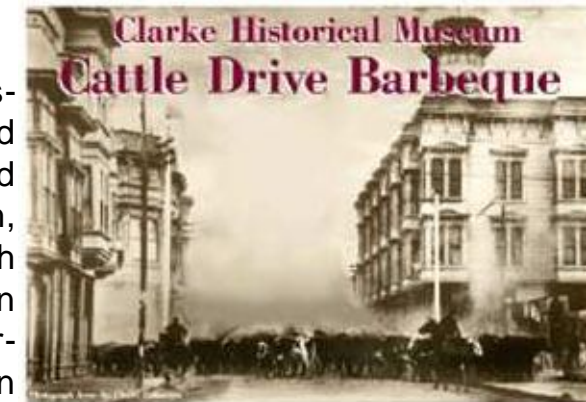

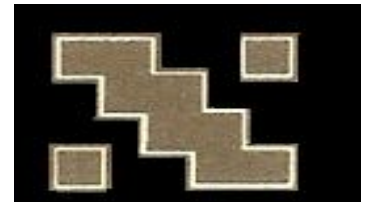


Come down and buy your tickets today!!!
