On December 12 and 13, take in a double-feature blast from Humboldt's past. At 5:30pm on those nights, the doors of the Eureka Theater will open for a showing of two movie versions of "Valley of the Giants". Both



were filmed in Humboldt County using locations in Eureka and along the Mad and Eel Rivers. These movies and two others were based on the popular 1918 novel by Peter Kyne. The story is a much fictionalized romance based loosely on the William Carson family with melodramatically good heroes and wicked villains. This double feature is a fundraiser event for the Clarke Museum and the Eureka Theatre, tickets are \$10.
