Rules

1. All contestants will be limited to these fuel sources: Wood, Charcoal, Wood Pellets. Absolutely no propane grills!
2. Contestants agree to prepare a minimum of 40lbs of meat
3. 4 people per team, team members eat for free
4. All contestants agree to have 60% of their meat cooked and ready to serve by 11:30 AM for the public. Chicken turn-in time for judging is at 12:00 p.m. for chicken, 12:30 p.m. for ribs. The remainder must be cooked by 2:30 p.m. For Judging Samples, each team will be provided a numbered Styrofoam turn-in box for each meat prepared, which will be delivered to the judges. Garnish is optional. If used, it is limited to chopped, sliced, shredded or whole leaves of fresh green lettuce, curly green kale, curly parsley, flat leaf parsley and/or cilantro.
5. Meat must be picked up at Blue Lake Casino the day before - Friday, June 9th between 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.
6. For those competing in the judged meat categories, meat will be inspected at Blue Lake Casino the day before - Friday, June 9th between 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.
7. Check in time will be Saturday, June 10th, between 5:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.
8. No vehicles will be allowed in the BBQ area without written consent after 8:00 a.m. on the day of the event.
9. No vehicles allowed in or out between 8:00 a.m. and 5 p.m. Saturday except for emergencies.
10. No pets, no exceptions.
11. Everyone other than team members will be required to leave the BBQ area by 10:00 a.m. Saturday.
12. Participants will be wrist banded at check-in.
13. Teams are required to use a meat thermometer and ensure proper food handling procedures at all times – teams found serving undercook meat will be disqualified
14. Teams competing for the People's Choice Award will need to provide samples to the festival-goers.
15. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies, so please include:
 - a. Bleach
 - b. Waterless Hand Soap
 - c. Hand & Surface Wipes
 - d. 5 gal. bucket
 - e. Metal bucket to dump hot coals DO NOT DUMP your coals on the ground, all fires must be in containers,
 - f. Fire extinguisher for their space: minimum rating of 5lb type AB
 - g. Foil lined cooler to keep hot food
 - h. Meat thermometer
 - i. BBQ or Smoker– we suggest at least 3 standard BBQs or larger
 - j. Pop-up tents are required by the Health Department
 - k. Tables for preparation and serving public
16. Spaces will be approximately 20'x30'. Electricity is available for an additional \$25 fee, though you must bring your own extension cords, which must be rated for 15 amps minimum and contain a ground wire.
17. All cooking devices, team members, tools, and accessories must fit within the allotted 20'x30' space.
18. Absolutely no firearms or explosives will be allowed.
19. All team captains must be 21 years of age or older and have valid ID.
20. Each team will be responsible for the cleanup of their space.
21. The Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guests.
- 22. Festive presentation, decoration and costumes are encouraged!**
23. Winners will be announced at 4:00 p.m.

CLARKE MUSEUM 4th ANNUAL "REDWOOD COAST UP IN SMOKE" BBQ COMPETITION RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

CLARKE MUSEUM: THIS CONTRACT LIMITS OUR LIABILITY – READ IT

Thank you for your participation in the Clarke Museum's 4th Annual "Redwood Coast Up in Smoke" BBQ Competition (the "EVENT"). As part of the competition, competitors are allowed to set up their own personal equipment at the event site, Blue Lake Casino & Hotel, 777 Casino Way, Blue Lake, CA 95525 (the "EVENT SITE"), beginning at 3:00 PM on Friday, June 9, 2017. Participants must vacate the EVENT SITE upon conclusion of the EVENT at 5:00 PM on Saturday, June 10, 2017, and remove all personal property from the EVENT SITE at that time.

Therefore, the undersigned understands and agrees that:

- 1. The Clarke Museum (the "Clarke") assumes no liability for theft, damage, or loss of any kind or nature to the undersigned's personal property including, but not limited to: BBQ equipment, vehicles, trailers, cooking utensils or instruments, or any other personal property deposited at the event site beginning at 3:00 PM on Friday, June 9, 2017. The undersigned understands and agrees that depositing personal property at the EVENT SITE creates no obligation or duty on the part of the Clarke to protect the undersigned and his or her personal property from any loss, theft or damage except to the extent imposed by law as a gratuitous bailee.**
- 2. The undersigned shall indemnify and hold harmless, the Clarke, or any of its officers, employees, representatives, agents, or assigns from any and all liability, loss or damage the Clarke may suffer as a result of any claims, demands, costs, or judgments against the Clarke arising from the negligent acts of the undersigned while participating in the EVENT or arising from undersigned's actions at the EVENT SITE.**
- 3. This general release constitutes the understanding of the undersigned, and by signing undersigned acknowledges that he or she has read and agrees to the terms stated in this agreement.**
